INFORMATION AND REGULATIONS:

- 1. Entry forms should be in as soon as possible, preferably by Monday, June 26. 2017
- 2. Marshalling area: On July 1, floats gather at the School Board office area by 11 am for judging. Colour Party, marching groups, first responder units, any non-competitive entries and decorated bicycles should gather no later than 11:30 am
- 3. Parade begins at 12 noon.
- 4. Parade route: Starting from the School Board Office, right onto Muchalat Drive and right again onto Nimpkish Drive. Continue on Nimpkish Drive until Nimpkish Park. The parade will stop on the right hand side of Nimpkish across from the park to allow people off the floats and the marching groups to walk across to the Park. The floats would then continue on up to the parking lot of Ray Watkins Elementary to disperse. There would be no parking of the floats across from Nimpkish Park throughout the afternoon.
- 5. Animal entries: Necessary clean-up equipment MUST accompany any entry.
- 6. Float prizes will be awarded during the 1 pm Ceremony in Nimpkish Park.

7. SAFETY REGULATIONS:

PLEASE NOTE THE VERY IMPORTANT CHANGE *** FROM PREVIOUS PARADES:

No candies, freezies, or other items are to be thrown from moving vehicles. If you wish to distribute treats for the children, please provide walking personnel on the side of your entry to hand them out directly to them. This would also cover any other materials, flyers, etc. that you wish to distribute.

- (a) No fires of any kind on floats.
- (b) Units must be designed for easy exit of the driver. Drivers must remain with the floats.
- (c) Floats must be equipped with an approved fire extinguisher.
